for hire which will be refunded upon safe return of the car. If you hire and purchase any new Morgan from us here at Brands Hatch within 1 month of your rental, we'll refund the full cost of the hire.

WRAPPING UP FOR WINTER

with Andy...

Driving a Morgan on a cold, clear, dry, sunny day during the winter months is undoubtedly good for car and soul. However, once Autumn colours fade, some Morgans get put away from winter salt and remain dormant for weeks or even months.



Unless precautions are taken, damage can result from this period of inactivity. We have seen this happen over the last year with cars being towed into the workshop so we wanted to take this opportunity to share a few tips about wrapping up for the winter.

We'll focus mainly on fluids, in particular petrol, and what needs to be done to preserve the fuel system to help ensure smooth running come springtime.

Firstly, if your Morgan is of the "traditional" variety (before about 2020) it ideally needs to be running on E5 fuel rather than E10. All modern fuels have a short shelf life – a matter of months in fact – before it starts to degrade and lose its potency, but that's only part of the problem when it comes to laying up your car. The Ethanol content in the fuel attracts moisture – made worse when the tank is left close to empty, therefore allowing condensation to build up. This condensation then ends up in the petrol, contaminating it and leading to corrosion problems which can include failed fuel pumps and blocked components.



The procedure we follow is to add a fuel stabiliser, top up the tank and then run the engine (at least 5 minutes) to make sure the stabiliser reaches all parts of the fuel system. This way condensation is minimised as there is little air in the tank, and also the fuel will stay in good condition until the car is brought out again. A few more tips if you intend to not use your car over the winter months:

- Increase tyre pressures to help avoid flat spots during storage – you could go to 40psi BUT make sure you put a note on the steering wheel to re-adjust before the car is driven again
- Leave the handbrake off (if safe to do so) to stop the shoes sticking to the drums





- The battery will appreciate (and last longer) if connected to a battery conditioner
- If the coolant/anti-freeze is more than 5 years old, it needs changing to avoid freezing but also to inhibit corrosion
- Engine oil needs to be clean get it changed if its due
- Little furry creatures mice and the like find Morgan interiors a very comfortable place to set up home. They also like eating leather trim and wiring these pests are therefore best deterred.
